

RANDOM ACTS OF KINDNESS KITS

A group will get together and assemble bags/kits for the homeless and distribute them randomly to those in need.

Impact

Cause: Provide much-needed relief and build hope for the homeless community in your local area.

Beneficiaries: The goal of these kits is to help those that are experiencing homelessness. These kits will benefit the homeless by providing sanitary/personal hygiene products that are not freely available in these living conditions.

Project description: Group will get together to compile items and build out kits/bags for distribution. Commonly needed items include mouthwash, toothbrush/toothpaste, deodorant, soap, hand sanitizer, wet wipes, granola bars, reusable water bottles, etc. The program leader could reach out to COGWA headquarters to request church booklets to place in each individual bag. Distribute the kits as a group or ask participants to keep them in their individual cars and hand them out to homeless people as they see them on the street.

Volunteer Benefits

This project will strengthen the volunteers serving attitude and skills. Taking time out of our busy schedules and making the choice to serve others develops a mindset of esteeming others higher than ourselves and develops our Christian character, use our bodies as instruments

- Compile a list of items to pack in reusable bags.

- Purchase Items and host event!
- Distribute the kits as a group or ask participants to keep them in their individual cars and hand them out to homeless people as they see them on the street.
