

PERSONAL HYGIENE / SANITARY PAD PROJECT

Provide personal hygiene items for women in areas where these items are not readily available.

Impact

Cause: Improve female education and confidence by eliminating the need for girls to miss school due to their periods.

Beneficiaries: Countries that have limited or no access to personal hygiene products results in female students missing school because of the lack of accessibility. This lack of necessity negatively impacts their education and future opportunities.

Project description: This program is a great opportunity to enable female students to continue educational opportunities their emotional and spiritual growth will be aided.

To begin, the program leader will contact an existing nonprofit to obtain the pattern and determine donation method.

After the program leader has organized and purchased supplies, the volunteers will work side-by-side to follow the sewing pattern for girls in need.

Finally, the group will donate the completed items according to the preferred donation method required by the benefiting non-profit.

Particpation Requirements

Moderate sewing skills and a sewing machine are necessary to complete this program. Age is not a limiting factor.

Group size: 5 participants minimum

Locations: Facility with multiple electrical outlets

Event duration: 4 to 6 hours
